BOYS

- White school shirt with school logo
- Cherry jumper under blazer
- Grey school shorts or pants worn with black school shoes and plain white socks

Shoes & Socks

SHOES

Simple, black lace-up leather shoes with a small heel between 1 and 3cm, with no adornments.

No runners, slippers, platforms or T-bar sandals

SOCKS & TIGHTS

White, above ankle or knee high and no logo embellishments. Navy opaque tights (with girls winter skirt only) No socks on the outside of tights

- White ankle sports socks with no logo embellishment
- Non marking runners



Hair & Facial Hair

OVERVIEW

The College Uniform Policy endeavours to recognise diversity and the needs of individual students, while also indicating acceptable standards of dress.

HAIR STYLES AND COLOUR

Clean natural styles and colours only. Hair styles must be compatible with OHS guidelines. No unnatural colour or combinations of colour, no partially or fully shaved heads, no beading.

HAIR ACCESSORIES

White, blue or black only

FACIAL HAIR

Boys should be neatly shaven at all times.

Adornments

Only minimal jewellery is permitted, and no obvious make-up or nail polish is to be worn.

Minimal jewellery and adornments are defined as:

TATTOOS

Illegal under the age of 18 and therefore strictly banned. Tattoos are not to be visible for students over 18 years of age

EAR PIERCING

A maximum of two small plain sleepers or small studs per ear

FACIAL AND VISIBLE BODY PIERCINGS Strictly banned

NECKLACES

One chain with or without religious/cultural insignia, to be worn under dress or shirt and not to be visible. No other necklaces are permitted

WATCH

Plain and discreet

BRACELETS

No bracelets permitted. Religious or medical alert bracelets with Principal's permission only

RINGS

One plain, discreet ring only

HATS

The Maribyrnong College hat (chosen to comply with the sun smart policy) is recommended but not compulsory. A plain navy beanie may be worn during recess and lunch breaks outside during winter.

NECK AND HEADSCARVES

One colour only, either navy or white

BAGS

School backpack or plain navy blue with no adornments



Compliance

- ♦ The uniform must be worn in a clean and tidy fashion.
- Shirts should not hang out below the jumper or blazer.
- ♦ Skirts and dresses must be at an acceptable length.
- No item of the school uniform may be modified.
- Uniform compliance is managed within a staged framework of response.
- ♦ The Principal will direct the management of exceptional circumstances.
- ♦ This uniform guide is endorsed by the Maribyrnong College School Council.
